



## COVID – 19 Best Practices

The staff of the Largo United Halloween Tournament is here to support you, your team, and parents during this tournament. We are doing everything in our power to help prevent the spread of COVID-19 and implement the following best practices to promote personal safety during the tournament.

These protocols will be in affect at each of the locations the Largo United Halloween Tournament is being hosted.

**Coaches and Team Managers:** Please share this important information wit your team’s parents and players.

### Tournament Play

- Hand Contact between teams is prohibited (i.e. post-game handshake, “high fives”, etc.)
- It is recommended that coaches wear face coverings.
- The home team will provide a cleaned (sanitized) game ball to the referee.
- Absolutely No Spitting on the field or sidelines.
- Existing team benches will not be used at any of the venues. Please bring your own portable bench if needed.
- Coaches will not have to present player passes before any game.
- Exiting teams should clear the playing field promptly when the match ends. Do not congregate at the complex with your team.
- Setting up tents and or large umbrellas around the complex is prohibited, unless it is to cover the bench area.
- Entering teams will wait for exiting teams to COMPLETELY clear the bench area before approaching.
- The Largo United Halloween Tournament will not have hydration stations available, please make sure you provide your own water.
- Anyone who becomes ill during the even is asked to leave the venue immediately and report all occurrences to the team manager.
- All Players and coaches will have to sign a liability waiver of consent to play during the COVID-19 pandemic before being

### Spectator

- Spectators are allowed during the competition and must sit in the designated spectator area.
- Spectator are not permitted to sit on any benches and or stands at any venue.
- Spectators much observer social distancing of 6ft in the spectator area and sit a minimum of 4ft from the sideline.
- Spectators CANNOT enter the team area for any reason.
- Spectators are encouraged to wear PPE and bring your own sanitizer.
- Anyone who is sick, or experience symptoms related to COVID-19 – STAY AT HOME.
- Anyone who becomes ill during the tournament is asked to leave immediately and report all occurrences to the team manager.
- Do not congregate after your game has been completed. Please exit the complex promptly.
- It is recommended to wear a mask while at the facility “in public”

We will continue to develop and implement procedures as we get closer to the event.
